

FAQs – MISHA Library

Does the library provide access to the Database?

- MISHA library has access to “JSTOR” (Social Sciences) database. Also, you can access the MAHE Centrally accessed databases through our library global library web page.

What are the library timings?

- Our library is open from 9:00AM to 8:00 PM (Monday to Saturday; except MAHE holidays).

How can I access the library resources?

- You can access the library resources either physically (by visiting library) nor digitally (through MAHE Library Global Web Portal).

How do I search for library books?

- The library has an OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue) to search the MAHE libraries resources; through selecting a particular Institution library.

Is there any group study area?

- Sorry, library DO NOT have any group study area.

Can I suggest/recommend a book for the library?

- Yes, you can. Just you write an email to lib.misha@manipal.edu OR send a request through “Global Library Web Portal” by clicking “Ask Librarian”. But the HOI must approve to procure the same.

Where can I find question papers of previous years?

- You can find recent previous year question papers through the Library Global Web Page. For the old question papers, it is kept @ the library circulation counter.

Does the library have Wi-Fi?

- Yes, the library has free ‘iBus Wi-Fi’ facilities for our students. You can connect to the iBus Wi-Fi Services by registering into it.

Does the library have a remote access facility?

- Off course, yes, the library has an “OpenAthens” remote access; and you could find through our library web page.

Can I borrow a book from the other campus (Lake / Valley Campus)?

- Yes, you can borrow a book from both the campuses. But you must return the book to the same campus library, where you have borrowed.

Is it possible to get a book from other libraries of MAHE, Manipal campus?

- Yes. You just send a request to us, then we will get the same through “Inter Library Loan” facility for a short time (i.e. may be for one or two days).

Is ‘Plagiarism’ software being available in the library?

- Yes, library has “Turnitin” plagiarism software. You can use the same by registering.
